

The Martha and Kenneth Revoir Scholarship Application

The Martha and Kenneth Revoir Scholarship is a memorial scholarship primarily available to eligible members of Saint Katharine Drexel Parish. In addition thereto, the Trustees have the authority to award scholarships to students who are members of other Roman Catholic parishes in New Britain. **A student/applicant must have been a member of his/her parish for at least one year prior to application.**

The Martha and Kenneth Revoir Scholarship was established in 2016 by Kenneth Revoir in memory and in honor of his mother, Martha Revoir, a parishioner of Saint Maurice Church, now known as Saint Katharine Drexel Parish. The Scholarship is primarily to provide financial assistance to eligible students who have been members of Saint Katharine Drexel Parish for at least the year prior to application. Scholarships of a minimum of \$2500 may be awarded to full time students who are enrolled at accredited colleges, universities or community colleges or are pursuing a course of study which will prepare them for a trade or profession at an accredited educational facility which awards degrees or certificates and has a full time faculty. High school seniors who will be enrolled at an accredited educational facility by June for the fall semester are also eligible to apply. It was Mr. Revoir's intention, in creating the scholarship trust, to assist eligible students pursue the education for which they are qualified and which they wish to pursue in order to become useful, productive citizens. Scholarships may include assistance with tuition, fees, books, and living expenses.

Tax returns should not be provided to and will not be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. Under the terms of the Trust, the Trustees are charged with considering each applicant's "academic performance and their need for financial assistance."
